
A. How to access SKYEYE Lite Vehicle Tracker.

SkyEYE recommends modern web browsers such as Firefox or Chrome

- 1) Double Click on the SVT (SkyEYE Lite vehicle Tracker) icon on the desktop¹ or, single click the Skyeye Lite icon in the bookmark bar of your web browser.



- 2) Enter Username and Password in the prompt dialog and then click on the Login button

B. How to navigate the map

- To Pan

Left Click + Hold on the map and then move it around or

Click on the map navigation arrows to move left, right, up or down

- To Zoom In or Zoom Out

Use mouse scroll wheel (if available) to zoom in or zoom out

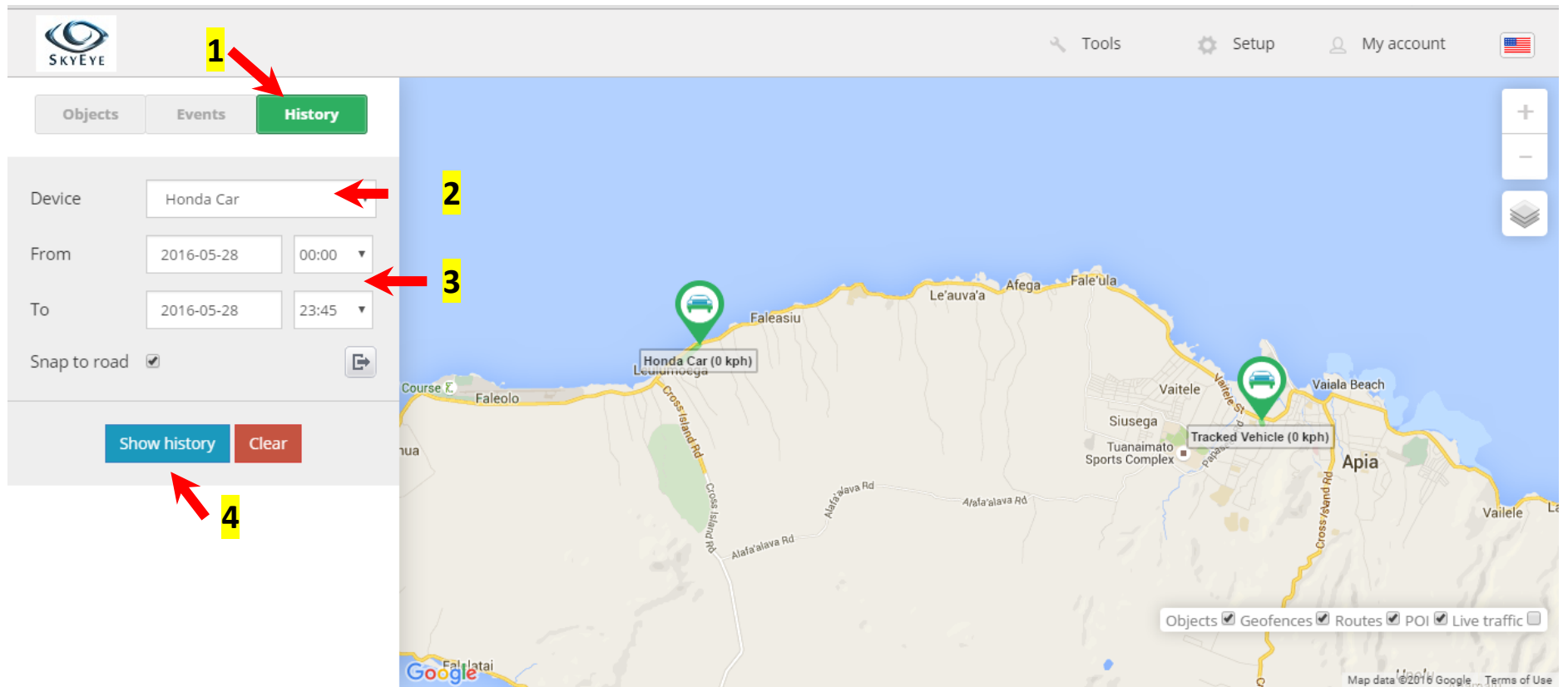
Or

Click on the “+” on the ZOOM bar level to zoom in and on the “-” to zoom out.



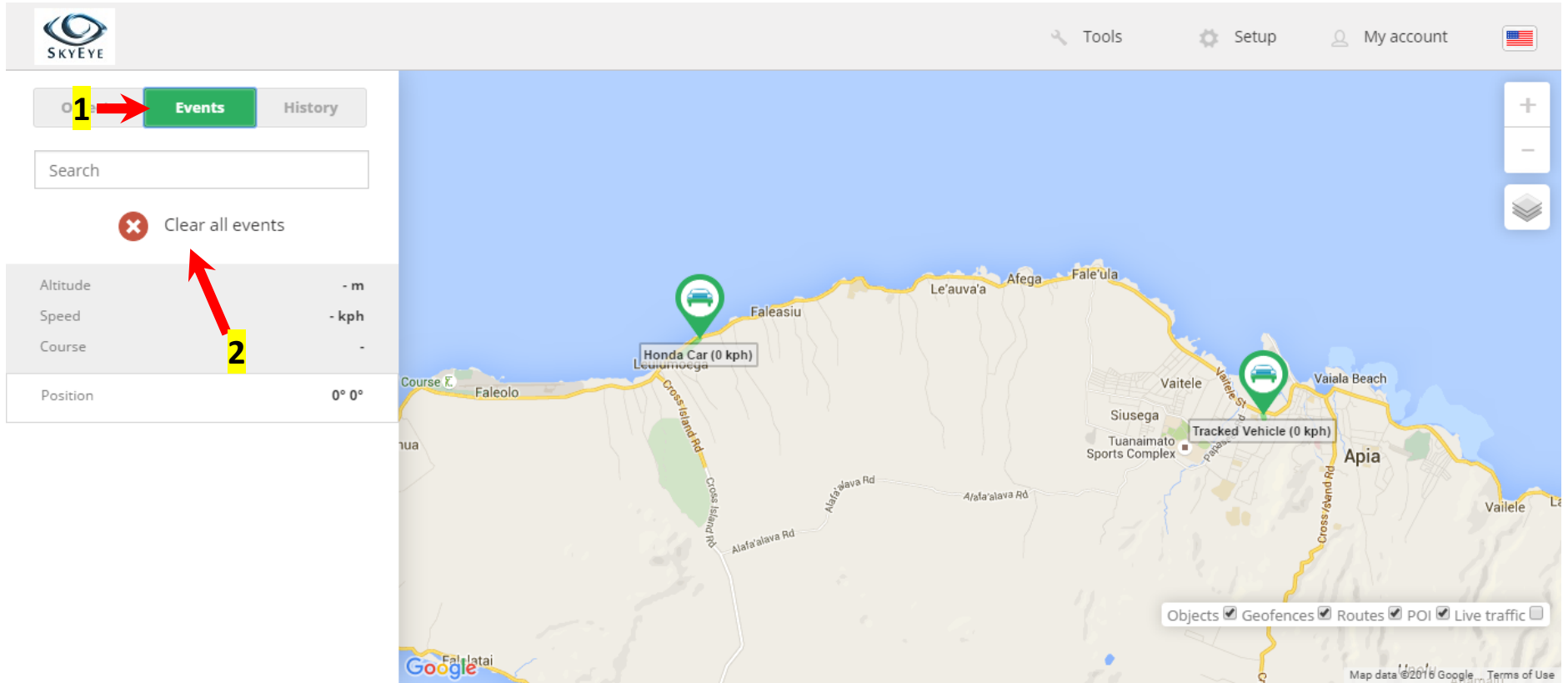
C. How to visualize vehicle track history for a certain period/day

- 1) Click on the history Button (1). Select vehicle to visualize history (2). Select From and To period of interest (3). Click on Show History



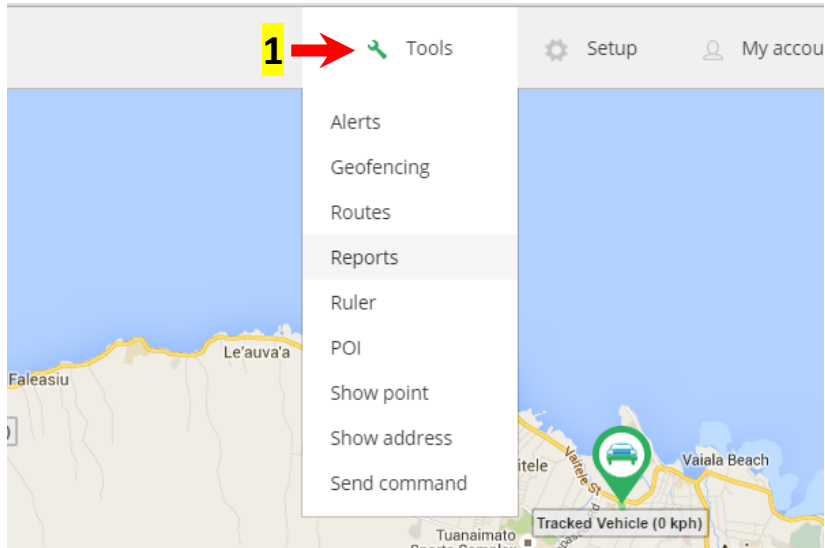
D. How to view Alerts/Events

1) Click on the events tab. View any events if any

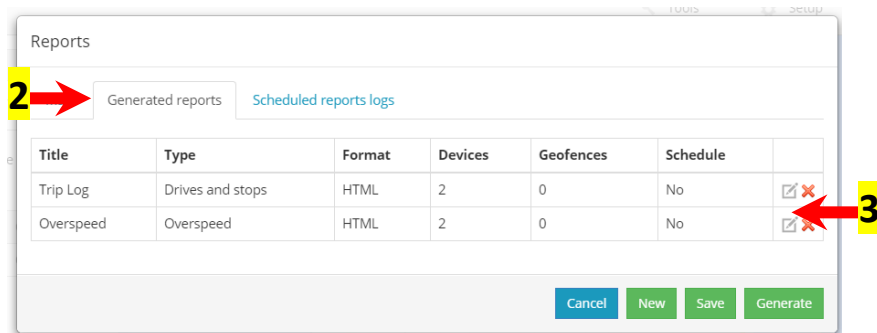


E. How to generate and view vehicle reports

1) Go to Menu -> Tools -> Reports.



2) Click on the Generate Reports Tab. Select the report to generate



3) In the Reports Dialog. Select Parameters desired. Devices (Cars to be part of the report). Format (Format of the report). Date (period of report). Click on Generate.
